### Hot Chocolate Fundraiser

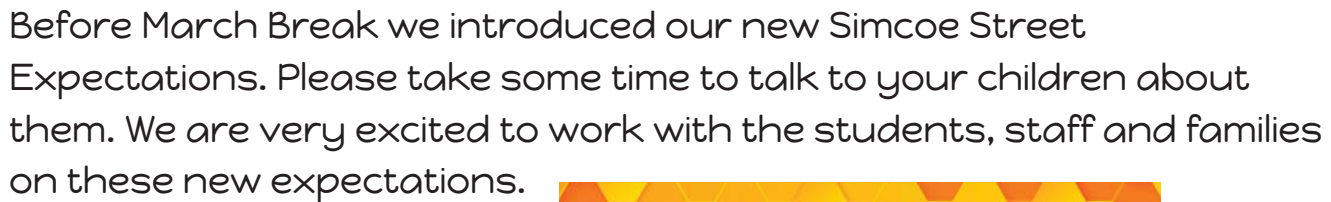
