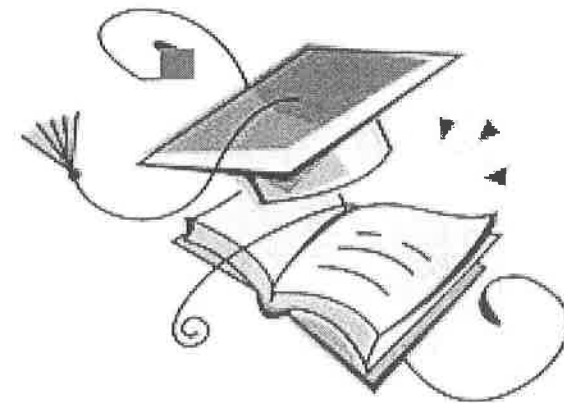


### Citizenship AWARD Criteria

This student demonstrates	What it means or looks like:
Tolerance	Honouring and accepting individual differences, culture, views, beliefs or opinions of other students.
Compassion/ Kindness	Showing concern or empathy for others, being gentle, willing to help, friendly and considerate toward others.
Responsibility	Carrying out a task or duty carefully and thoroughly, being dependable so that teachers or 'kids can count on you' in any classroom group work or activity. Shows regular school attendance and being on time for school.
Self-discipline	Working hard to control his/her emotions, words or actions so as not to hurt anyone physically or hurt anyone's feelings.
Respect	Shows high regard for other students, those in position of authority, cares for school property and the school surroundings.
Co-operation	Working together with all teachers/staff, Principal/Vice Principal and other students to achieve a common goal.
Perseverance	Hard working and never giving up and waiting calmly without complaining. Displaying GROWTH MINDSET .
Sportsmanship	The ability to take winning and losing gracefully during ANY classroom/sports activity or subject area.
